## Sonora Elementary COVID-19 Summative Report

This report provides summative information about COVID-19 positive results for our school community, since we began in-person instruction on September 8th for our 1st through 3rd grade students and September 14th for our TK/K and 4th through 8th grade. **This is the total number of cases for the 2020-2021 school year**, up to this point in the year.

A positive case is a person who receives a lab-confirmed positive COVID-19 test result.

Student cases are counted from our total student population of 711, from both in-person instruction and virtual independent study rosters.

Staff includes are all of our employees: administrative, certificated, and classified staff.

Our first positive case involved a student and was reported on November 17th.

There have been 4 student/staff positive cases in the past 14 days, which represents a 14 day positivity rate of approximately 0.5%.

We will continue to keep communication and transparency with updates as we proceed. Thank you for your patience during this difficult time and we are proud to have been able to stay open for on campus instruction and be able to serve all of our students. This is possible because of the extremely hard work of **all of our staff**, teachers, paraprofessional aides, campus supervisors, cafeteria, custodial, transportation, office staff and school administration, in no particular order. We are thankful for all of them and, most importantly, thankful for the wonderful children that attend Sonora Elementary!
